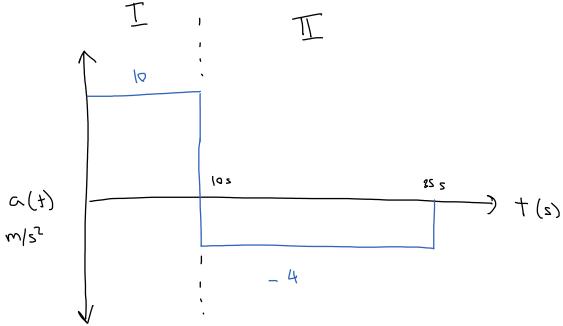
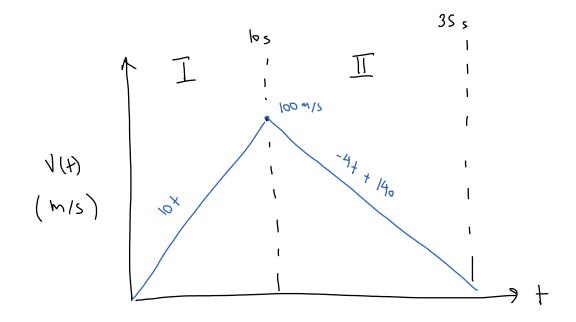
Question 1:

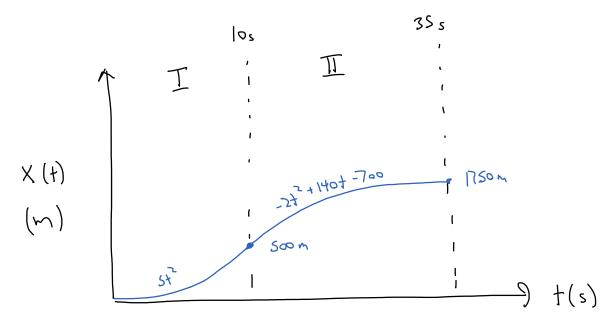
